Alison Cuninghame Trophy 2009

Rules & Guidelines:

- The venue for the matches should be the **home course of the 1st player** of each pairing as highlighted on the draw sheet.
- The “1st Player” status for all Quarter-Final matches will be decided by draw at the C&H Girls’ Get-Together at Girton GC on Sunday 25th January 2009. The “1st Player” status for Semi-Final matches will be decided by draw on Sunday 15th March 2009.
- The 1st player is responsible for contacting their opponent to arrange a suitable date/time for the match (please allow ample time before the closing date of the round just in case bad weather forces a course closure postponement).
- If a match hasn’t been arranged after 2 weeks of the round’s commencement the **2nd player’s home course will become the venue** and the 2nd player will make the arrangements.
- Failure to play a match before the closing date of the round will lead to **BOTH** players being disqualified from the next round**.
- A ‘match’ will consist of 1 round of 18 holes, continuing to extra holes if required to determine a winner (with any handicap stokes being applied as per the previous 18 holes).
- Handicap allowance is the FULL DIFFERENCE of the two handicaps, applied at the appropriate holes. Competitors must play off their current club handicap. If, due to a recent score, there is a downward adjustment pending, the player must make such a reduction to her playing handicap as shall be appropriate under the handicapping scheme. If the competitor is in any doubt, or if any upward adjustment is pending, confirmation must be obtained from the player’s club before the handicap can be increased.
- The **Alison Cuninghame Final** and **Plate Final** will be played at a neutral venue and the Organiser will liaise with the finalists to find a suitable date/time.
- All queries, disputes and problems should be reported to the Organiser or a member of the Junior Committee and their decision will be final.
- For this competition all competitors must be aged under 18 (on 1st January 2010), be a member of a Cambs & Hunts affiliated club and have a current CONGU handicap of 36 or below.

****Any player having difficulty in organising a match should speak to the Organiser ASAP**.**
