CONDITIONS / QUALIFICATIONS AND FURTHER INFORMATION:

- 1.1 The competition is open to players who are members of a recognised golf club within the counties of Bedfordshire, Cambs & Hunts, Essex, Hertfordshire, Norfolk and Suffolk; who have amateur status in accordance with the current Amateur Status Rules of R & A Rules Limited and who hold an Active CONGU handicap or equivalent at the date of entry. Handicap limit 40 combined.

Regulations

- 2.1 Entries shall be limited to 40 pairs.
 2.2 Entry forms accompanied by the appropriate entry fee must reach the organiser by the closing date.
 2.3 In the event of entries exceeding 40 pairs a ballot will be held after the closing date. Entries balloted out will be kept on a reserve list. Unsuccessful entrants will have their entry fees refunded.
 2.4 The draw for partners will be made after the ballot.
 2.5 Competitors must register at the registration desk no later than 30 minutes before their first tee-off time.
 2.6 A current Active CONGU Handicap certificate must be produced before the end of play - failure to do so will mean disqualification.
 2.7 Any competitor who is aged under 14 must be accompanied by a responsible adult.
 2.8 The Committee has the authority to arrange/alter tee times.
 2.9 In the event of adverse conditions, the Committee reserves the right to alter the format of the competition in order to achieve a result.
 2.10 A pair withdrawing after the closing date must inform the organiser Margaret McCall (Tel: 01223 276779, Email: margaret.mccall@ntlworld.com.) Entry fees are non refundable after the closing date unless the organiser has a substitute.
 2.11 In all matters, the decision of the Competition Committee is final.

Conditions

- 3.1 The competition shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf and the Local Rules as approved by the Competition Committee.
 3.2 The competition shall consist of 36 holes Foursomes medal.
 3.3 Pairs will tee off in the same order in both the morning and afternoon rounds
 3.4 The handicap allowance will be as per CONGU Regulations for foursomes medal.
 3.5 In the event of a tie after 36 holes the winners will be decided on a count back over the last 18, 9, 6, 3 or 1 hole(s) on the card of the final round. Players may only win one prize.
 3.5 If a player arrives at her starting point, ready to play, within five minutes after her starting time, in the absence of circumstances that warrant the waiving of the penalty of disqualification under Rule 33-7, the penalty for failure to start on time is TWO STROKES in stroke play. Penalty for lateness beyond five minutes is DISQUALIFICATION.
 3.6 The ball used must be on the R&A Conforming Ball list. Penalty - Disqualification.
 3.7 Distance measuring devices may be used.
 3.8 Competitors should walk at all times during the competition unless prior permission has been granted from the Committee. Penalty - Disqualification.
 3.9 Competitors may not engage a professional or assistant professional as a caddy. Penalty - Disqualification.
 3.10 The Competition Committee will monitor the pace of play and will take action under the Rules of Golf if players are considered to be delaying play.
